

Dogs taking heartworm preventives should be tested every year.

Grounded or Unfounded?

FACT: All dogs should be tested annually for heartworm infection.

Annual testing is important, even for pets receiving preventive medication yearround, to ensure that the protective program is working. A dog can become infected if just one dose is missed, given late, or spit out and can rub or swim off a topical preventive.

BEST STRATEGY: The only strategy schedule an annual heartworm test for every pet on preventive medication.
