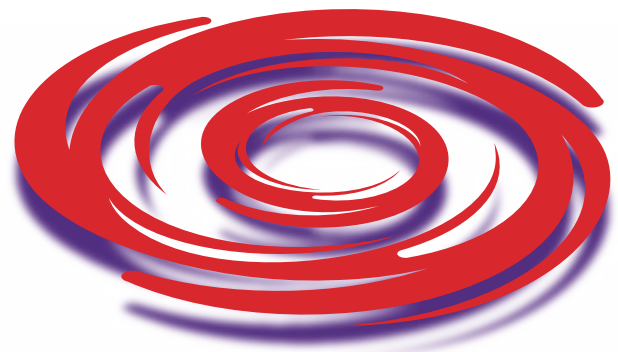

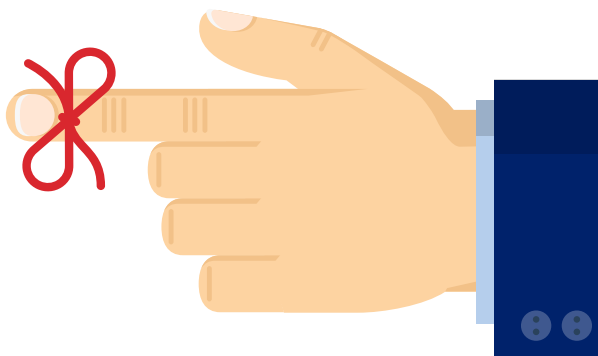
### **MANY MAMA MOSQUITOES**

Heartworms are spread by hungry mosquitoes. More mosquitoes mean more exposure to heartworms.



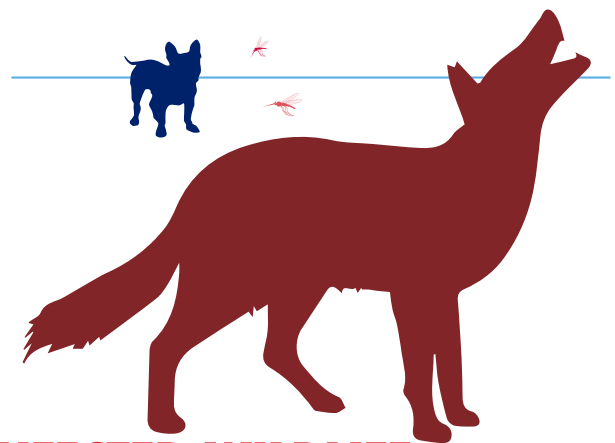
### **HURRICANES & FLOODS**

Mosquitoes breeding in floodwaters + infected pets = a lethal combination.



### **SKIPPING DOSES**

Forgetting a dose of heartworm preventive or giving medication seasonally can leave pets unprotected.



### **INFECTED WILDLIFE**

Mosquitoes bite infected wild animals, then transmit the infection to pet dogs, cats, and ferrets.
